RULES

- 1. Tire size in classes up to 16.9 is 5500. 18.4 can be used in 6500 and up.
- 2. Drivers under 18 years of age must have parent signature.
- 3. Pull becomes official after 20 ft.
- 4. Only rubber tires allowed. Tires may be cut.
- 5. Drawbar height 20 in. max. measured from top of hole in drawbar (pull point) to the ground.
 - Minimum length 18 in. from the center of the rear axle to the center of the hole. Only loop or clevis hitch. NO ball or hooks.
- 6. One tractor can pull in two classes.
- 7.If tractor or sled touches boundary line, the pull ends.
- 8. All Antique Classes have a 4 mph speed limit.
- Add on weights allowed. Weights may extend 11 ft. from the center of the rear axle.

- Weights will be securely fastened. Weights or any objects falling from the tractor while it is hooked to the sled, will be disqualified.
- 10. Tractors will be weighed with the driver.
- 11. Tractors being operated in an unsafe manner will be disqualified.
- 12. Distance pulled will determine the winner.
- 13. Driver must remain seated at all times.
- 14. Front end raises more than 18 in. will be flagged.
- 15. Tractors must retain stock appearance.
- 16. Factory High RPM, 20% override allowed.
- Outlaw Classes are any gear any RPM scatter shield or blanket required.
- 18. JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
